TRAVEL VACCINATIONS

If you are going away on holiday or business, you may need travel vaccinations depending on the country or countries you are planning to visit.

Certain vaccinations are recommended in some circumstances, e.g. repeated or lengthy visits to rural areas/ backpacking trips/high risk activities/work.

You need to start your vaccinations **4 weeks** before your departure date, whenever possible, for the required protection.

Some vaccines are not available at the surgery and you will be advised to make your own arrangements with other travel clinics who will charge a fee.
